

ABOUT GALLERY ROUTE ONE

Gallery Route One (GRO) is a nonprofit 501(c)3 art organization supporting a contemporary art gallery and community service projects. The gallery and its programs are maintained by a Board of Directors, a small, part-time staff and 20+ artist members.

Gallery Route One is located at 11101 Highway One, Point Reyes Station, California 94956. The gallery is open free to the public 11 am to 5 pm every day except Tuesday. Ph: 415.663.1347. To find out more information about GRO and its programs visit www.galleryrouteone.org/

In addition to exhibiting work by its member artists, GRO exhibits work in the Project Space by artists from the Bay Area and beyond on themes focused on the environment, immigration and social justice issues.

GRO is the home of the annual Box Show, holds a Juried exhibition for Northern California artists annually, and serves the West Marin Community through its Latino Photography Project and its Artists in the Schools Program.

The organization was founded in 1983 by 25 artists who joined together to create a professional-level exhibition space and gathering place for artists and to serve the community through the visual arts.

Our mission: To originate and present contemporary art exhibitions, educational programs and community outreach to inspire people to experience the world in new ways.

In an average year, GRO presents 21 exhibitions in its three gallery spaces. Exhibitions are six weeks in length. Over 12,000 people visit GRO during the year, including 5,000 who come to see the annual Box Show. The Gallery Shop sells American artisan-made arts & crafts.

GRO, now celebrating its 35th year, receives a high level of recognition and support in the West Marin community and the Greater Bay Area for sponsoring innovative exhibitions and initiating creative community service projects.

12 MONTH FELLOWSHIPS FOR ARTISTS 21 TO 35

Fellowship Period: July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019

Gallery Route One Fellowships offer artists an opportunity to be involved in the life of a working gallery, to have one solo exhibition and participate in group exhibitions and events during the fellowship year.

Two Fellowships are awarded each year. Applicants are automatically entered for both. The Senior Fellow is given a solo exhibition in the Center Gallery with a \$400 stipend to offset the associated costs for a post-card and hosting the reception. The Emerging Fellow has a solo exhibit in the Annex Gallery and receives a \$200 stipend. Both Fellows have the opportunity to exhibit in member group shows and in the Alcove small works gallery.

The Senior Fellow is required to serve as gallery attendant once every 6 weeks. Both Fellows are expected to assist in one or two gallery chores. Both Fellows are required to attend 4 member meetings per year. Fellows are invited to participate in gallery functions such as receptions, talks and parties. Fellows are eligible for full membership after their Fellowship year.

Application Fee: \$15

Eligibility: Artists aged 21 to 35, living in the Greater San Francisco Bay Area, convenient to Point Reyes Station (with their own means of transportation), working in any fine art medium; no crafts.

Application deadline extended to April 30, 2018

Notification for round one will be April 30, 2018. Finalists will be interviewed in person, and asked to bring 3–4 recent pieces of current work. Finalists may be asked to provide proof of age.

On acceptance Fellows are required to sign a contract covering their responsibilities to Gallery Route One for the 12-month Fellowship period.

PREPARE YOUR ONLINE SUBMISSION

Images:

You may upload 10–12 images of your artwork in jpeg format at highest quality. Images should be no larger than 2MB overall. Video clips must not be more than 3 minutes in length. Sculptors may submit one additional view of each piece. Image filenames should be in this format: LastName-Artwork-Title.jpg without any punctuation except short dash and period.

Statements / Documents:

- -Artist Statement outlining your philosophy and approach to creating your art (500 words or less).
- -Brief statement outlining why you would like to be a GRO Artist Fellow. (200 words or less)
- -Résumé of your education, exhibitions, and work history, along with links to your web site or blog.
- -Name and contact information for one reference.
