



MAKE AN ART BOX TO PUT STUFF IN

A paper sculpture by Pamela Blotner

You will need: paper, ruler, scissors, pencils, markers or crayons and glue, paste or tape.

1. Take a sheet of paper and trim it to a square, this one is 8 1/4" x 8 1/4"
 2. Divide the sheet into 9 equal squares. For a sheet that is 8 1/4 x 8 1/4, each square will be 2 3/4 x 2 3/4 inches.
 3. Fold and smooth along the lines in each direction
 4. Create a drawing in each square except the squares marked "Leave blank." I used colored pencils but any medium will work except maybe paint that could wrinkle the paper.
 5. Make four cuts along the folds shown by the thick red lines.
 6. Begin to fold upward, center squares first.
 7. Fold and glue sides 3 and 4, then fold and glue the squares with your artwork.
- Your box is finished! Use it to hold things, or to display all by itself; make two and stack them.
