- A strong portfolio of completed work as well as work in progress
- A committed fine-arts practice
- An interest in and desire to participate in the work of Gallery Route One as outlined below under Fellowship Benefits and Fellowship Responsibilities

Fellowship Benefits

- Solo exhibition in the Annex Gallery
- Two-person exhibition in the Main Gallery
- \$400 stipend to help with the costs of producing the exhibitions
- Assistance in identifying and securing outside funding
- Promotion for the solo and two-person exhibitions on the GRO website and in social media, broadcast media and print media
- Inclusion in the annual Artist Members' exhibition
- Inclusion in GRO's annual Box Show
- Inclusion in the Alcove Small Works Gallery
- Knowledge of and direct experience in producing exhibitions and other aspects of gallery management
- Paid participation in GRO's Artist in the Schools program(optional)
- Mentoring from gallery staff and artist members in areas of interest to the Fellow

Fellowship Responsibilities

- Gallery sit (approximately 6 hours every 6 weeks)
- Perform a mutually agreed upon gallery job at the gallery and/or off-site (approximately 4-6 hours a month)
- Attend virtual, monthly Artist Member meetings
- Attend in-person Artist Members meetings and/or GRO organizational meetings
- Attend in-person GRO events at the gallery such as exhibition receptions, fund raising activities, and/or community outreach activities.
- Co-host a reception for the solo and two-person exhibitions

Gallery Route One (GRO) is non-profit 501(c)3 art organization with vigorous exhibition and community service programs. GRO is operated by a Board of Directors, a part-time staff, and 20-25 Artist Members. The gallery is located in a rural area of West Marin County, a one-hour drive from San Francisco and the East Bay. Over 10,000 people visit the gallery each year.
