IMPORTANT DATES:

- Box return datesSunday, July 11, 5- 7, Monday, July 12 and Tuesday, 13, 2021, 11 - 2
- We need a full 10 days to photograph and upload all of the boxes and artist statements to our website. If you do not return your finished boxes at one of those times it will just makes things more difficult and confusing for us.
- Show dates.....July 24, 2020 – September 11, 2021
- Opening Event Sunday, July 25, 2021, 3 to 5 pm

BOX MAKING RULES

1. With a few caveats (below) Artists can do anything to the box, but it (not an image of it) must be included in the final work. Also please write one page about your Box for the Box Story binder available in the Gallery during the Show and for inclusion on our website. Write about creating it, or about the story it tells, or your inspiration, or ...
- 2. FINISHED WORK OF ART NOT TO EXCEED 30" IN WIDTH and 48" IN HEIGHT**
- 3. Finished box must weigh less than 20 pounds**
4. No live animals or plants/flowers.
5. No toxic smelling materials.
6. Box cannot be altered or taken apart during the show.
7. **Batteries have been very problematic in the past.** Please wire your Box if it is to be lit or has motorized parts.
8. Put hanging hardware on the back of your Box for wall installation.
9. No advertising or self-promotion on the Box.
- 10.Boxes must be made by a person 16 years of age or older.
- 11.No overtly violent imagery

PLEASE TAKE SIZE INTO CONSIDERATION:

Not only is wall space limited with 150 pieces to show, we have extremely limited storage space and we struggle to store large Boxes that are waiting to be picked up by their buyers. Transporting or mailing a large Box can also be challenging.

1. Two slips of paper (=/- 1/4 of a sheet of letter sized paper) with the following information:

Your name as you would like it displayed in the show

Phonetic spelling of your name if can easily be mispronounced

Title of box

One will stay with your box, the other used for data entry

2. Printed Artist Statement - This one will stay in the gallery

We will give you 15 postcards each for you to send out. They require a letter stamp.
