Our mission: To originate and present contemporary art exhibitions, educational programs, and community outreach to inspire people to experience the world in new ways.

Founded in 1983 by 25 West Marin artists, GRO now hosts over 20 exhibitions each year with new shows opening every five to six weeks. Over 15,000 people visit annually, including 7,000 visitors during our legendary Box Show fundraiser.

Gallery Route One (GRO) is a non-profit, 501© (3) arts organization and is recognized locally and nationally for innovative exhibitions and community arts programs, and continuously exhibits work in three gallery spaces by member and nonmember artists from the Greater Bay Area, the US and beyond. GRO is located on the unceded ancestral homeland of the Miwok people and we acknowledge the historical and contemporary harm this has caused. Gallery Route One is addressing this through invitational exhibits of work by local artists of Coast Miwok, Pomo, and Ohlone ancestry, as well as other Native people of California whose lives have been deeply impacted.

12-MONTH FELLOWSHIPS AT GALLERY ROUTE ONE

For over four decades, Bay Area artists have joined together at Gallery Route One for mutual support and artistic collaboration. In that time GRO has become an important part of the cultural life of an area unusually rich in creative energy.

Fellowship support is reciprocal, and, in that regard, we look forward to what Fellows bring to the gallery by way of fresh artistic expression. It is our hope that Fellowship opportunities will work as a catalyst for accelerated artistic growth for Fellows and Artist Members alike.

Gallery Route One will award 12-month Fellowships for up to two artists.

GRO Fellows will have an opportunity to show their work in up to 6 exhibitions which include one solo show, and one 2-person show, and will receive a \$1000 stipend to offset the associated costs. They will be highlighted in GRO marketing and promotions.

In addition to mentoring by experienced artists, Fellows will have the opportunity to be hired as a Teaching Artist in GRO's Artist in the Schools program.

Who may apply:

Artists living in the Greater San Francisco Bay Area, convenient to Point Reyes Station, and working in any fine art medium. Fellowships are open to Emerging Artists aged 21-40. BIPOC artists are encouraged to apply.

Applicants will be judged on:

- Quality of work
- Dedication to artistic practice
- Willingness to work in a collaborative way with other artists
- Interest in learning about a nonprofit gallery and community service

We encourage our Fellows to engage in the gallery in order to familiarize themselves with the unique characteristics of a 510(c)3 art organization. This can include participation in a special event to introduce Fellows to the Board and Artist Members, attending gallery openings, and participating in Artist Member meetings.

Timeline:

The application deadline is October 31, 2023. Notification for round one will be in November. Finalists will be invited to the gallery for a personal interview and review of artwork in December.
